

This document contains the standings for the 2024 Tokessy tournament. It corresponds with Schedule version 1.6
 It will be updated and published each night with completion of all round robin and playoff games.
 Congratulations to all participating teams, hope to see you again in 2025 at the 28th Annual Tokessy Tournament.
 If there are any schedule discrepancies, the published schedule prevails.

On Saturday August 3, thunderstorms struck at approximately 7:20 pm, suspending games in progress and causing the fields to become unplayable. Approximately 14 games were affected. The committee met late Saturday night and decided to proceed with the following considerations in mind. Most of the suspended games were not at the 'official' game status, and on average were about about 3 innings in. It would be impossible to finish all of these games on Sunday and still have a viable playoff stream that would end at a reasonable time. Almost all divisions had a mix of local and out of town teams. We decided to analyze each division on a case by case basis and determine the most appropriate path forward given the data we had (games already completed) for each division. After consideration we determined that 4 of the above games were necessary to complete playoff eligibility determination. We prioritized ensuring that any remaining possible playoff teams had a chance to finish their game in progress (or scheduled) to determine their own fate. We wanted to ensure and identify those potential playoff teams and notify them as soon as we could as those games would have to be completed before any playoff games could occur - these were all subsequently scheduled for approximately 8am Sunday start times. Thank you to the volunteers (and coaches and parents) who helped get these still wet fields ready for play earlier than scheduled, and on short notice, as well as umpires who did the same.
 When those 4 games were completed we were able to proceed with playoffs as previously scheduled.

Rather than finish this game we decided to base the ranking on fewest runs allowed over the 2 completed games. Fayetteville #1 with 1 run allowed; R-Noranda #2 with 3 runs allowed South Ottawa and Orleans have completed 3 games each, and are both 2-1. No head to head, Orleans ranks #3 based on fewest runs allowed 7, South Ottawa runs allowed 17 ranks them #4

Playoffs: Mississippi v UOVLL game is relevant as both could still qualify, so will be played in the Sunday 8:30am slot at WBW. If Mississippi wins, then Kanata and Mississippi are #1 and #2 depending on final total runs against. If UOVLL wins we have a tie for 2nd between UOVLL and Mississippi. UOVLL wins tiebreaker on head to head win over Mississippi. Effectively, winner of Mississippi v UOVLL proceeds to final. If UOVLL and Mississippi tie, Mississippi wins tie breaker on lower runs allowed.
